

Multi-factor Authentication

To set up Multi-factor Authentication on your account, continue with the instructions below.

To proceed from the "Multi-factor Authentication is **not enabled**." message, first click the "Send a code by email" button further down the page.

The system will then send a six-digit code to the email address of the logged-in user and display a field on the page to confirm the code.

Enter the code sent to your email into the "Authentication Code" field and click "Save". The code sent to your email is valid for 2 minutes.
